(Estimated City Share of Road Project - \$41,075,673, Estimated City Share of Water and Sewer Improvements - \$11,347,267).
- K. To approve final payment in the amount of \$5,709.60, plus interest on retainage, for Sterling Relief Drain Right of Way Improvements, City Project #19-335.
