## **Interested in Serving on a City Board?**

The City of Sterling Heights is successful because of the tremendous support from residents who voluntarily serve on various city boards and commissions. Board and commission members support city operations by supporting department initiatives, advising city officials on important matters and serving as ambassadors in their respective neighborhoods.

Those interested in serving in a voluntary capacity on a board or commission may submit an application to the Office of the City Clerk. Applications will appear in the public agenda at which time the City Council will discuss recommendations, may make nominations and vote on appointments.

At this time, the City is looking for a Housing Commission member as well as an Ordinance Board of Appeals member.

The **Housing Commission** oversees the Public Housing Authority and Housing Choice Voucher Programs. Members serve a five-year term.

The **Ordinance Board of Appeals** strives to preserve property values through strict enforcement of maintenance standards. The Board reviews cases that have become a nuisance as a result of property owner failing to comply with these standards and may approve immediate abatement by a City contractor at the property owner's expense. The Board also considers requests for variances from City ordinances as authorized by City Council. Members serve a three-year term.
