Dear Resident:

On August 20, 2019 the City Council awarded the contract for the resurfacing of Fox Hill Drive from Dequindre Road to Ryan Road. Construction is tentatively set to begin Monday, September 9, 2019, weather permitting. The project will entail milling off the existing asphalt overlay and provide a new asphalt driving surface. Private residential driveway approaches are not included in the scope of repair. Two-way traffic will be maintained throughout the asphalt milling and asphalt paving operations. Mail service and trash pick-up will be undisturbed.

The intent of this project is to address the deteriorated pavement with a new asphalt drive surface. It is not the intent to resolve standing water issues. It is anticipated that some standing water will remain upon completion of the project.

Please comply with the following important concerns through the course of the construction:

1. Please keep all children away from the construction machinery and crews.
2. Please restrict the lawn sprinkling of areas adjacent to the street. Setting sprinklers to run during the evening hours is preferred.
3. Please refrain from parking in the street during the duration of this project.
4. Be careful to not drive or walk in the "Tack Coat". This is the emulsion/glue we spray between the asphalt pavement layers.
5. Please refrain from parking on the street for the first 24 hours after paving is complete.

The contractor for this project is Asphalt Specialist, Inc. They may contact you with necessary requests and updates to the project, such as removing vehicles from roadway to help complete the project.

We anticipate the work to be completed within 6 to 8 weeks. Updates to the progress of the project can be located on the "Cone Zone" section of the City website at www.sterling-heights.net.
